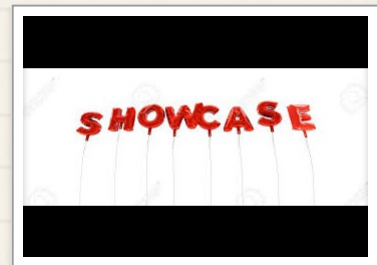

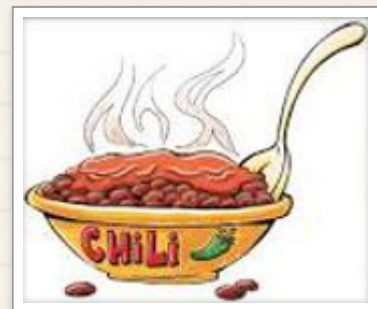
## Pennies for Patients

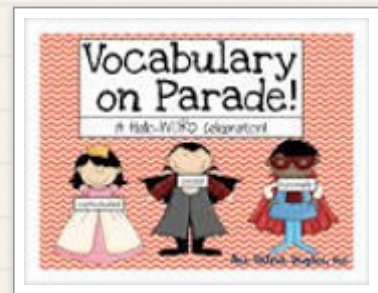

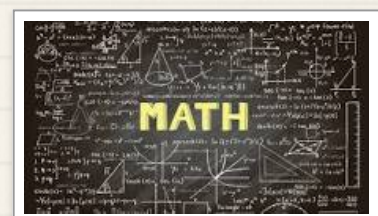
Here are the STAAR dates for our 3rd-5th grade students.

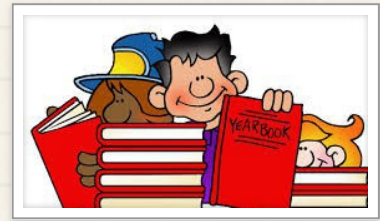
