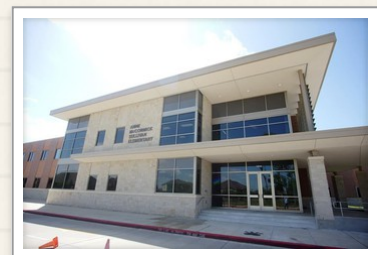

Student Honored

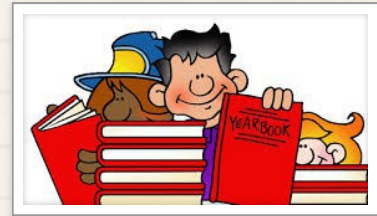
