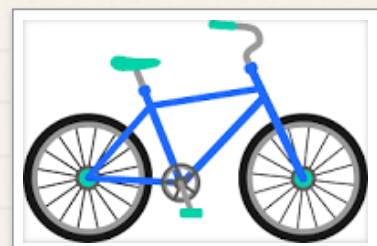


## WATCH Week

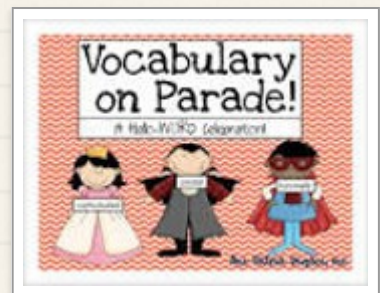

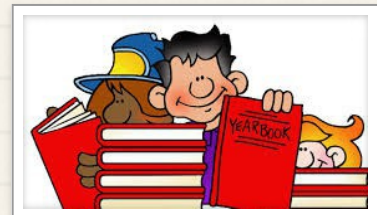
